#### **Counter Height/Bar Height**



#### **Tools Required**

- Hammer •
- #2 Square Head Bit
- Power Drill
- 7/16" Socket or 7/16 wrench

### **Included Hardware**



#### Instructions:

- 1. Unpack items from box(es). Be sure to match any numbers & letters that you may find on the pieces.
- 2. To begin, lay the leg/back combo on a flat surface. Line the seat up with the lines drawn on the leg/back combo. Fasten using 2 (B) 2" Screws. Repeat on the other side of the seat. (Illustration 1).
- 3. After fastening the seat, fasten the two leg braces to the leg/back combo lining them up with the lines drawn on the legs. Using the pre-drilled holes on the brace, fasten using 1 (B) 2" Screw on each brace. (Illustration 2)
- 4. Next place the front legs in place, using the pre-drilled holes on the seat, fasten using 2 (B) 2" Screws on each side. (Illustration 3)
- 5. Then fasten the legs to the braces, using 2 (B) 2" screws on each brace. Fasten where the brace falls; do not force. (Illustration 4)
- 6. To fasten the front step, with the pocket holes facing outward (rounded edge to the back), line up the brace with the marks and fasten the foot brace using two 2 (B) 2" screws. Repeat on other side. (Illustration 5)
- 7. Placing the step on the brace and fasten the step in the brace using 4 (C) 21/2" Screws (Illustration 6) and then the brace into the step with 4 (C) Screws. (Illustration 7)
- 8. To finish, fasten the last front seat slat, using 2 (A) 11/2" screws on each side. (Illustration 8)
