# CURVE BACK ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

# 406 4' Gliders




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## **Tools Required**

- Hammer
- #2 Square Head Bit
- Power Drill
- 7/16" Socket or 7/16 wrench

### Included Hardware



### Instructions:

- Unpack items from box(es). Be sure to match any numbers & letters that you may find on the pieces.
- To begin, set the seat upright. Set the back into the seat. Fasten the end using 2 (B) ¼" x 2½" Carriage Bolts & 2 (E) ¼" Nuts. Repeat on the other side. Then fasten the back in the center using 2 (A) ¼" x 2¼" Carriage Bolts & 2 (E) ¼" Nuts. (Illustration 2)
- Lay the glider on its back and fasten the arm and leg combo. Fasten the arm of the arm/leg combo to the back using 1 (C) ¼" x 3" Carriage Bolt & 1 (E) ¼" Nut. Then fasten the legs of the arm/leg combo using 4 (D) ¼" x 3½" Carriage Bolts & 4 (E) ¼" Nuts. (Illustration 3) Repeat on the other side.
- 4. With the glider still laying on its back, fasten the glider rails to the glider base.
  Fasten using 4 (F) ¼" x 3" Lag Bolts.
  (Illustration 4) Repeat on the other side.


