
426 4' Benches



Tools Required

- Hammer
- #2 Square Head Bit
- Power Drill
- 7/16" Socket or 7/16 wrench

Included Hardware



Instructions:

- 1. Unpack items from box(es). Be sure to match any numbers & letters that you may find on the pieces.
- 2. Set the back into the seat. Align the pre-drilled holes. Using 4 (B) ¼" x 2½" Carriage Bolts & 4 (E) ¼" Nuts, fasten the seat on both ends. Use 2 (A) ¼" x 2¼" Carriage Bolts & 2 (E) ¼" Nuts to fasten the seat in the center. (Illustration 2)
- 3. After fastening the back, lay it on its back. Fasten the arm of the arm/leg combo to the back using 1 (C) ¼" x 3" Carriage Bolts & 1 (E) ¼" Nut. Then fasten the leg of the arm/leg combo to the seat using 2 (D) ¼" x 3½" Carriage Bolts & 2 (E) ¼" Nuts. (Illustration 3) Repeat on the other side.
- 4. Turn the bench upside down, resting on the arms. Now fasten the legs using 6 (D) 1/4" x 31/2" Carriage Bolts & 6 (E) 1/4" Nuts. Use two bolts for each leg. (Illustration 4)
- 5. Then using 2 (G) 2½" Screws, fasten the legs to the back braces. (Illustration 5)
- 6. Now fasten the leg brace using 6 (F) 2" Screws. Line up the leg brace with the marks on the leg and hold flush with the end of the leg. Be sure the center leg is straight. Use 2 2" screws on each leg. (Illustration 6)






