## #79A Hi Back Balcony Swivel



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## **Tools Required**

- Hammer
- #2 Square Head Bit
- Power Drill
- 7/16" Socket or 7/16 wrench

## Included Hardware

## Instructions:

- 1. Unpack items from box(es). Be sure to match any numbers & letters that you may find on the pieces.
- To begin, fasten the arms to the back and seat base using 2 (A) ¼" x 3"
   Carriage Bolts, 2 (B) ¼" Nuts, & 1 (D) ¼" x 3½" Lag Bolt. (Illustration 2) Repeat on the other side.
- After the arms have been fastened, removed the second seat slat (closest to the back) using a #2 Square head bit. (Illustration 3)
- 4. Turn the swivel plate till all the pre-drilled holes on the base are aligned. Using (C) ½" x 1½" Lag Bolts insert the bolt into the 4 pre-drilled holes. Do not tighten until all 4 lags have started, then tighten. (Illustration 4)
- 5. Re-fasten the second seat slat that you removed in step three. (Illustration 5)




